SOPHIA

WE COMPLIMENT EACH OTHER AND KEEP EACH OTHER STRONG WE SHARE OUR SENTIMENTS AS WE JOURNEY ALONG SHARING OUR LIVES YOU FOR ME, AND ME FOR YOU AND WHEN WERE IN A RUT I CAN ALWAYS COUNT ON YOU

SOPHIA/HEATHER

MY PARTNER AND MY BUDDY ALWAYS SPECIAL IN MY HEART AS YOU SHARE YOUR LIFE WITH ME YOU SHARE YOUR SOUL, SO FREE

SOPHIA

EXTRAORDINARY, YOU RATE

HEATHER

EXTRAORDINARY

SOPHIA

TRULY, I CAN APPRECIATE

HEATHER

I CAN APPRECIATE

SOPHIA/HEATHER

THAT ROAD WILL NEVER BEND, OR END YOU ARE MY FRIEND, MY FRIEND WE'RE ALWAYS TOGETHER THAT WILL NEVER END EACH ONE HERE FOR THE OTHER WE HAVE NO OTHER PLAN AS WE GO DOWN THAT PATH

SOPHIA

YOU ARE MY FRIEND

HEATHER

YOU ARE MY FRIEND

SOPHIA

YOU ARE MY BEST FRIEND

HEATHER

YOU ARE MY BEST FRIEND

SOPHIA/HEATHER

YOU ARE MY FRIEND, MY BEST FRIEND

HEATHER

You're a beautiful woman with so much going for her. But, in this one particular area, you seem to have a blind spot.

SOPHIA

How come you didn't have a pattern like this?

HEATHER

I had my own problems. Guys never hit on me. I had to learn how to get a guy's interest without him knowing I was doing it.

SOPHIA

Come on, Heather, you had lots of dates and experience.

HEATHER

I'm not the sexy like you. When I lost my innocence, it was because I wanted the guy and wanted the experience. It wasn't because I didn't know how to say no.

SOPHIA

Hey.

HEATHER

Oh hush. I had to get the guy interested in me, or it would never have happened. I had to make my own social life. I learned to handle rejection and developed a skill set that worked for me.

SOPHIA

I never chased a guy. There are always so many around that I can just - well - almost just pick one. But you developed a skill set to get guys interested in you. That is like marketing a product - that's my skill set.

HEATHER

Well, you definitely need to get a better skill set to meet better guys.

(she pulls out her smart phone)

I heard on NPR about this behavioral psychologist Jake Kelly that specializes in social and sexual relationships. Something about the way beautiful women are raised, what kinds of men hit on them, etc. There's a link to him on the website. His topic was, "the beautiful woman syndrome and the invisible man".

SOPHIA

There is a professor who teaches about beautiful women. Sounds like BS to me.

HEATHER

I'm not kidding. You're entitled to develop a relationship with a guy and find your soul mate. What you are doing now, is having a frustratingly disappointing sequence of one night stands.

SOPHIA

I don't need a shrink.

HEATHER

You've been complaining about some guy almost every time we meet and I've always been a listener, but I don't know what to tell you. Maybe, the Professor could give you some pointers.

SOPHIA

Who wants to face their shortcomings - especially in sex and —.

HEATHER

Relationships. Saying the word is the first step to having one. Come on, call him and make an appointment. I'm sending you the link.

(HEATHER types on her phone. SOPHIA's phone chirps message received)

SOPHIA

Professor Jake Kelly, Clinical psychology. I'll call him when I get home.

HEATHER

Call him RIGHT NOW!

SOPHIA

OK. Keep your panties on.

HEATHER

You first.

(SOPHIA dials the phone. HEATHER drains her wine glass)
